### **To Become a Member:**

Teens must present the following:

1. Identification showing date of birth
2. Teen member waiver that must be completed and signed by a parent or guardian
3. Code of conduct signed by teen and parent or guardian

### **Cost:**

A teen membership for the basic facilities is \$15 per month\*

**\*Please note that you are responsible for your \$15 payment per month, whether you use the facility or not.**

You will be expected to pay your membership fee within the first 5 days of the month, or upon your first visit to the facility that month if it is after the 5 day period.

***Failure to pay your membership fee may result in the termination of your facility access until the dues are paid.***

If you are not able to use the facility, please notify us and we can terminate your membership or put it on hold so you don't generate a balance on your account.

### **Membership Benefits:**

Teen members are welcome to:

1. Use the basketball court during open gym times
2. Swim during lap or recreational times
3. Use the free weights, cardio room, and the boxing area

### **Restrictions:**

Teen members may not use the YMCA facilities between 8:00 AM and 2:00 PM on weekdays during the school year, excluding vacation times.

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## Minor Participant Waiver, Release, Indemnification of All Claims & Covenant Not to Sue

**PLEASE READ CAREFULLY. THIS DOCUMENT EFFECTS YOUR LEGAL RIGHTS AND IS LEGALLY BINDING. BY SIGNING THIS AGREEMENT YOU ARE RELEASING THE CAMBRIDGE YMCA FROM ALL LIABILITY AND FOREVER GIVING UP ANY CLAIMS THEREFORE.**

### Assumption of Risk

I, in my legal capacity as the parent/guardian of the minor named below ("Minor"), acknowledge and agree that any use of Cambridge YMCA facilities, services, equipment and premises ("Facilities") and any participation in Cambridge YMCA programs and activities ("Programs") comes with inherent risks including, but in no way limited to: (1) moderate and severe personal injury, (2) property damage, (3) disability, (4) death, and (5) sickness or disease. I voluntarily, for myself and Minor, accept and assume full responsibility for these risks as well as any and all other risks of the use of Facilities and participation in Programs. I agree that I have full knowledge of the nature and extent of all such risks and am not relying on all such risks being described in this document.

### Waiver, Release, Indemnification & Covenant Not to Sue

In consideration of Minor's use of Facilities and participation in Programs I, in my legal capacity as parent/guardian of Minor, agree on behalf of myself and Minor that the Cambridge YMCA, its officers, directors, agents, employees, volunteers, insurers and representatives ("Releasees") will not be liable for any personal injury, property damage, disability, death, sickness or disease incurred by Minor, however occurring including, but not limited to, the negligence of Releasees. I understand that Minor and I will be solely responsible for any loss or damage, including personal injury, property damage, disability, death, sickness or death sustained from the use of Facilities and participation in Programs.

I further agree, in my legal capacity as the parent/guardian of Minor, on behalf of Minor, myself, and any and all legal successors and proxies, to release and **HEREBY DO RELEASE, WAIVE AND COVENANT NOT TO SUE** Releasees from any causes of action, claims, suits, liabilities or demands of any nature whatsoever including, but in no way limited to, claims of negligence, which Minor, myself, and any and all legal successors and proxies may have, now or in the future, against Releasees on account of personal injury, property damage, disability, death, sickness, disease or accident of any kind, arising out of or in any way related to the use of Facilities or participation in Programs, whether that participation is supervised or unsupervised, however the injury or damage occurs, including, but not limited to, the negligence of Releasees.

In further consideration of the use of Facilities and participation in Programs, I, in my legal capacity as parent/guardian of Minor, agree on behalf of myself and Minor to **INDEMNIFY AND HOLD HARMLESS** Releasees from any and all causes of action, claims, demands, losses, suits, liabilities or costs of any nature whatsoever, including claims of negligence, arising out of or in any way related to the use of Facilities and participation in Programs.

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## **Cambridge YMCA Code of Conduct**

The Cambridge YMCA is committed to providing a safe and welcoming environment for all of our members and guests. To ensure safety and comfort for all, we ask individuals to act appropriately at all times while they are in our facility or while they are participating in YMCA programs.

We expect persons using the YMCA to behave in a mature and responsible way and respect the rights and dignity of others. Our Code of Conduct does not permit language or action that can hurt or frighten another person or falls below a generally accepted standard of conduct. Specifically this includes:

- Angry and/or vulgar language including swearing, name-calling and shouting.
- Wearing inappropriate attire. Attire must include swimsuits only in the pool area; sneakers, shorts and shirt or leotard in other areas of the facility. Clothing with vulgar or profane writing or pictures is not allowed.
- Harassment or intimidation with words, gestures or body language. Behavior which is inappropriate, threatening or offensive in nature.
- Members and guests will refrain from using a cell phone camera or any other camera while in the YMCA unless you are photographing an approved YMCA event or competition. Cameras and cell phones in the locker rooms, restrooms, saunas, steam rooms, Child Care, and shower areas are strictly prohibited.
- No sleeping on the premises.
- Children over the age of 3 years are not permitted into Locker Rooms of the opposite sex.
- Children under the age of 13 must be accompanied by an adult at all times.
- Physical contact with another person in any angry, threatening, or unwanted way.
- Any demonstration of sexual activity or sexual contact with another person.
- Stealing or behavior which results in destruction of property.
- Carrying or concealing any weapons or devices that may be used as a weapon.
- The sale, possession, distribution, or use of any illegal substance (including alcohol & marijuana) by an individual on Y property is prohibited and will constitute grounds for immediate termination and possible prosecution.
- Smoking. All YMCA facilities and grounds offer a smoke free environment.

**The YMCA conducts regular sex offender screenings on all members, participants, and guests. If a sex offender match occurs, the YMCA reserves the right to cancel membership, end program participation, and remove visitation access.**

Members are encouraged to be responsible for their personal conduct and safety and to ask any person whose behavior threatens their personal comfort to refrain. Staff are trained and expected to respond to any reported violation of our Code of Conduct. Please don't hesitate to notify a staff person if you need assistance.

The YMCA management will investigate all reported incidents. Suspension or termination of YMCA membership privileges may result from any violation of the Code of Conduct.
